- B) From Parents: To ascertain the views and opinions of the parents, parent meets are arranged periodically. Detailed information about the parents meet is conveyed to the parents well in advance. The parents meeting is addressed by the Principal, IQAC Coordinator, Head of the departments, senior staff members. Parents freely express their views, raise queries and doubts which are addressed by the Principal and documented at the time of meeting. A feedback questionnaire is obtained from parents evaluated and analyzed. The Principal reviews the report submitted by the IQAC Coordinator and ensures effective implementation of the course of the remedial actions.

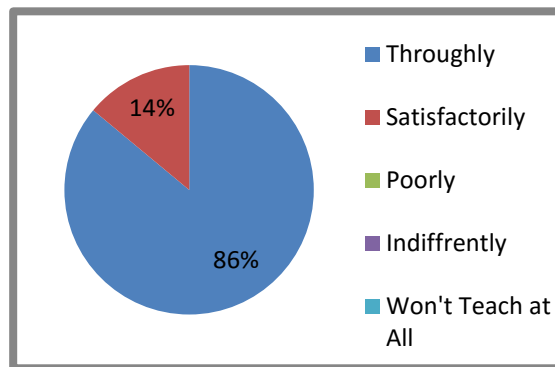
