## E-WASTE DISPOSAL AGREEMENT

This E-waste Disposal Agreement ("Agreement") is made on 1 March, 2022, by and between

Kavikulguru Institute of Technology and science, Ramtek (K.I.T.S., RAMTEK) located at K.K.Nagar, Parsoda, Ramtek Dist. Nagpur, 441106 Maharashtra, INDIA., hereafter called K.I.T.S. RAMTEK which expression shall unless repugnant to the context include its legal/authorized representatives, administrators, executors, nominees, successors and permitted assigns as the FIRST PART.

AND

Triratna Computers, Ramtek having its registered Office, Near SBI Mini Branch, Gandhi Chouk, Ramtek Dist. Nagpur -441106 hear after called T.C.R. which expression shall unless repugnant to the context include its legal/ authorized representatives, administrators, executors, nominees, successors and permitted assigns) as the SECOND PART.

Whereas K.I.T.S., RAMTEK has IT and all electrical, electronic products/ service related hardware material or any other material as may be specified by K.I.T.S., RAMTEK (the "Material" as hereinafter defined) that it may from time to time wish to dispose of, and T.C.R. InfoTech desires to execute complete dismantling & disposal program on behalf of K.I.T.S., RAMTEK.

Therefore, K.I.T.S., RAMTEK shall provide, and T.C.R. shall dismantle & dispose off the Material in accordance with the following terms of this Agreement:

- 1. Waste Material-** Waste Material is hereinafter defined as waste of all forms of electronics equipments, IT equipments like Desktops, Monitor, Laptop, Servers, Modems and converter, Multiplexes, Switches, XDSL, ADSL, Wireless radio, DCME, Backhaul Optimization, Optical, CPE telecommunications equipments, including but not limited to e-waste in the form of laptops, desktops, servers, network personal equipments, monitors, telephony, printers, faxes, copiers, data assistants process control equipment, server towers, server racks, scanners, batteries, server battery backups, uninterruptible power supplies, electronic storage media and all accessories and peripherals for above mentioned equipments including toners which K.I.T.S., RAMTEK may want to recycle. Waste Material specifically excludes equipments containing radioactive materials, free flowing liquids, chlorofluorocarbons, polychlorinated biphenyls, or other "Hazardous Wastes".

2. **Services**-T.C.R. shall provide following services to collection, transportation and destruction of Waste Material from various locations of K.I.T.S., RAMTEK . K.I.T.S., RAMTEK will notify Triratna Computers for pickup as per the accumulation of WEEE (Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment) with different locations pan India. collection of the Material, within 10 working days or case to case from date of notice duly informed by K.I.T.S., RAMTEK by an authorized representatives. T.C.R. shall destruct the entire quantity of Material within 15 working days of receipt of material. T.C.R. shall provide to K.I.T.S., RAMTEK written confirmation by "certificate of destruction".

3. **Payment**- T.C.R. shall bear all handling costs for the Waste Material collected from K.I.T.S., RAMTEK in full and all costs associated with the provision of the Services rendered. T.C.R. shall pay to K.I.T.S., RAMTEK for the e-waste collected from K.I.T.S., RAMTEK , as per the rates specified Rs. 25 per Kg all inclusive.

#### 4. **Triratna Computers Representation and Warranties -**

4.1 In the performance of all Services to be provided hereunder, T.C.R. agrees to comply with all applicable permits, all central, state, and local laws, regulations and ordinances and all duly constituted authorities. Upon request of K.I.T.S., RAMTEK , T.C.R. shall furnish copies thereof in advance. T.C.R. hereby specifically agrees and confirms that it is fully compliant to undertake this work from K.I.T.S., RAMTEK in terms of the "E-waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 2011" and it possesses all the certificates mentioned under the said Rules.

4.2 T.C.R. will be responsible for the statutory compliances including environmental compliances pertaining to the activities and Services mentioned above, "E-waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 2011" and K.I.T.S., RAMTEK will not in any way be responsible for the same once the Waste Material is handed over by K.I.T.S., RAMTEK to T.C.R. .

4.3 T.C.R. has obtained all necessary permits, licenses and other central, state or local authorizations required to perform the Services and upon request of K.I.T.S., RAMTEK , T.C.R. shall also furnish copies thereof to K.I.T.S., RAMTEK .

4.4 T.C.R. shall keep and retain adequate books and records and other documentation consistent with and for the periods required by applicable regulatory requirements and guidelines pertaining to performance of the Services required by this Agreement said records, books and documentation relevant to the above-said purpose shall be available for inspection by K.I.T.S., RAMTEK upon reasonable advance notice.

4.5 T.C.R. shall not resell the Waste Material in the original form which has been collected from K.I.T.S., RAMTEK except after totally destroying the Waste Material.

4.6 T.C.R. agrees and undertakes to indemnify K.I.T.S., RAMTEK for any liability, claims including third party claims, legal actions against K.I.T.S., RAMTEK or any of its Directors/employees arising out of any negligent action or willful misconduct by T.C.R. . T.C.R. also agrees to indemnify K.I.T.S., RAMTEK and its Directors/employees from and against all losses, actions, proceedings, claims, demands, costs, wards, and damages however arising, directly or indirectly, as a result of breach of this Agreement by it.

4.7 T.C.R. shall comply at its own expense with all applicable local, national, regional laws ordinances, regulations, codes, standards, directives and agreements to the extent that any of them have the force of law, as applicable.

In addition, T.C.R. shall comply at their own expense with all laws, ordinances and/or directives of India, as they relate to the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, Child labor laws, data privacy laws, criminal reporting laws, environmental, health and safety laws or any similar laws in performance of its obligations under this Agreement. T.C.R. shall also comply with at its own expense any applicable law/ rules of any international authority, if applicable, pertaining to the mentioned services.

T.C.R. will be fully responsible for the personnel deployed by it for providing the Services to K.I.T.S., RAMTEK .

4.8 As an integral part of this Agreement, T.C.R. hereby represents that they or any of their officials or representative shall not give or promise to give any money or gift to any employee/official of K.I.T.S., RAMTEK to influence to solicit or secure this Agreement through a promise to pay a commission, percentage, brokerage or contingent fee. Further, T.C.R. warrants that they shall not give or promise any such money or gift, or exert or utilize such unlawful influence during the term of this Agreement or to secure or solicit any extension thereof. It is agreed that breach of this representation and warranty clause by T.C.R. shall be sufficient grounds for K.I.T.S., RAMTEK to immediately terminate this Agreement besides taking other legal recourse. Breach of this clause shall also be sufficient ground for K.I.T.S., RAMTEK to file legal actions as may be necessary. Breach of this clause shall also be sufficient ground for K.I.T.S., RAMTEK to stop/withdraw all instructions for Services and demand payment for Services rendered till date and also file legal actions as may be necessary. Further, in the event it is found that T.C.R. or its employees have worked in liaison with any of K.I.T.S., RAMTEK 's employees with the intention to defraud, and then in that event this Agreement may be terminated by K.I.T.S., RAMTEK . T.C.R. shall immediately inform K.I.T.S., RAMTEK of any incident whereby any of K.I.T.S., RAMTEK employee/s approaches T.C.R. and/ or its employees with the intention of colluding to commit any acts to defraud K.I.T.S., RAMTEK failing which T.C.R. will be deemed to be a party to such fraud and liable for any loss or damage caused to K.I.T.S., RAMTEK by the commission of such acts.

4.9 T.C.R. shall ensure that the Waste Material is transported safely and there is no leakage during transit.

4.10 T.C.R. confirms and warrants that the Waste Material so collected by it under this Agreement shall not be misused by it directly or indirectly or dealt with in any other manner other than as expressly stated in this Agreement, and agrees to indemnify K.I.T.S., RAMTEK in case such representation/warranties of T.C.R. are breached.

- 4.11 T.C.R. shall ensure that all government approvals, statutory compliance as per E-Waste Rules as mentioned above and QEHS Quality, Environment, Health and Safety standards.

#### **4A BUSINESS CONTINUITY MANAGEMENT PLAN**

- a) T.C.R. shall ensure that at all times it has in place and is able to implement a business continuity and disaster recovery plan which will ensure the continued performance and operational resilience of the Services/ deliverable provided by T.C.R.
- b) T.C.R. shall be open to the audit of its business continuity arrangements by K.I.T.S., RAMTEK as and when required by K.I.T.S., RAMTEK

#### **5. K.I.T.S., RAMTEK Representations and Warranties**

5.1 K.I.T.S., RAMTEK has free and unencumbered title to all Waste Material delivered to T.C.R. pursuant to this Agreement.

5.2 K.I.T.S., RAMTEK shall not knowingly ship Hazardous Wastes to T.C.R. pursuant to this Agreement. In the event Hazardous Wastes are identified upon receipt at T.C.R. or during subsequent processing, such substances (as mentioned in Annexure-I) shall be quarantined, in manner sufficient to reasonably protect human health and real and personal property. T.C.R. will notify K.I.T.S., RAMTEK of identified substances and assist K.I.T.S., RAMTEK in the resolution and proper disposition of the substances, including lawful packaging, labeling and disposal. K.I.T.S., RAMTEK will be solely responsible for all related costs. Any decision in this regard will be taken after obtaining approval from K.I.T.S., RAMTEK .

6. **Term-** This agreement shall be in force for 1 year from the date of execution hereof ("the effective date") unless and until terminated in a manner set forth in paragraph 8.2 below or as provided for elsewhere in the Agreement. This Agreement may however be terminated by K.I.T.S., RAMTEK at any time during the term, without giving any advance notice to T.C.R. , in case T.C.R. fails to comply with its obligations under this Agreement.

7. **Independent Contractor-** In furnishing Services pursuant to this Agreement, T.C.R. will at all times be acting as an independent contractor and this Agreement will not be construed to create any association, partnership, joint venture, relation of principal and agent or employer and employee between K.I.T.S., RAMTEK and T.C.R. or its agents.

#### **8. Miscellaneous -**

8. **Miscellaneous** –

- 8.1 All services performed by T.C.R. for K.I.T.S., RAMTEK while this Agreement is in effect shall be subject to provisions of this agreement unless otherwise agreed in writing before the performance of such services is started.
- 8.2 This Agreement may be terminated at any time by K.I.T.S., RAMTEK or T.C.R. , upon 30 days' written notice to the other party. In the event of such termination, the parties will be paid for services performed or amounts due for Waste Material processed up to the date of such termination and not thereafter.
- 8.3 If any provision of this Agreement is held invalid or unenforceable, then it shall be considered severable (only to the extent necessary) and the remaining provisions will not be impaired and this Agreement will be interpreted as far as possible to give effect to its stated purpose.
- 8.4 This Agreement constitutes and fully expresses the entire and only agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof; all prior and collateral understandings, agreements and promises with respect thereto are considered merged herein. This Agreement may not be modified, waived, or extended unless mutually agreed to in writing, and it may not be terminated except as provided above. A waiver by either party of any terms and conditions of this Agreement in one or more instances will not constitute a permanent waiver of such terms and conditions unless so stated in writing.
- 8.5 **Confidentiality:** Each of the parties shall hold in confidence all documents and other information, whether technical or commercial which has come to its knowledge and which has been supplied to it by or on behalf of the other party. None of the parties shall disclose any such information to any outsider/ third party except with the prior written consent of other party.
- 8.6 **Assignment of the Agreement:** No party can assign this Agreement to any third party without obtaining the prior written consent of the other party.
- 8.7 **Resolution of Disputes:** The parties shall endeavor to resolve any problem or divergence resulting from the interpretation or application of this Agreement in a spirit of co-operation and mutual understanding.

In the event of any dispute or difference arising out of / relating to this Agreement between the parties, the same shall be settled by arbitration in accordance with the provisions of Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 or any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof.



- 8.8 **Governing Law:** The rights and obligations of the parties under or pursuant to this Agreement shall be governed by and construed according to the laws of India.

8.9 Jurisdiction of courts: Courts in NCT of NAGPUR alone will have jurisdiction pertaining to all disputes arising out of or relating to this Agreement.
